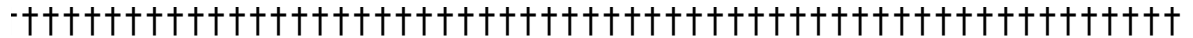

A model of the proposed retreat center rested on the deck for many years. Before the plan could be accomplished however, Mr. Culligan's health declined, and his vision was abandoned.
