New Stations of the Cross were commissioned as a result of a generous donation. They are constructed of a bronze steel. Here we see volunteers, young and young at heart, installing them! How blessed we are to have them in this "**Year of Mercy.**" Remember that St. Faustina stressed that we should recall

at 3:00 PM every day "The Hour of Great Mercy" when Jesus died on the Cross for us. During this hour, Jesus asked St. Faustina to pray the Stations of the Cross.

Bricks—the McGlones prepare to place the 50 bricks ordered over last winter. They join over 650 engraved bricks throughout the Shrine. The bricks remind us of our loved ones, births, ordinations, first communions, and God's Blessings to family and friends.
